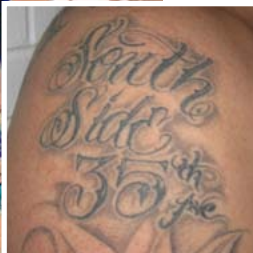




Seventh Annual
